MiLBVV	mirafiori lettuce big-vein virus	lettuce
OYDV	onion yellow dwarf virus	garlic, leek, onion, shallot, and other <i>Allium</i> spp.
PepMV	pepino mosaic virus	tomato, potato (can be artificially infected)
PMMoV	pepper mild mottle virus	pepper
Poty group	potyvirus group	various
PRSV	papaya ringspot virus (= watermelon mosaic virus 1)	cucumber, squash, watermelon, other cucurbits, papaya, etc.
PVX	potato virus X	potato, tomato
PVY	potato virus Y	pepper, potato, tomato
RaMV	radish mosaic virus	cabbage, arugula
SLCV*	squash leaf curl virus	bean, cucurbits
SqMV	squash mosaic virus	cucumber, squash, other cucurbits
TBSV	tomato bushy stunt virus	tomato, pepper, artichokes
TCSV**	tomato chlorotic spot virus	tomato
TMV	tobacco mosaic virus	beet, pepper, cucurbits, bean, tomato
