ASPV	Apple stem pitting virus	apple, pear
CLRV	Cherry leaf roll virus	cherry, peach, walnut, elderberry
CTLV	Citrus tatler leaf virus (= apple stem grooving virus)	citrus, orange
CTV	Citrus tristeza virus	citrus
PeAMV	Petunia asteroid mosaic virus	cherry, plum
PDV	Prune dwarf virus	cherry, peach, plum/prune
PNRSV	Prunus necrotic ringspot virus	cherry, plum/prune, apricot, peach, hop
Poty group	Poty virus	various
PPV	Plum pox virus (Sharka)	plum, apricot, peach, P. mahaleb and other Prunus species, sour cherry (new discovery)
PRSV	Papaya ringspot virus	papaya
PVYV	Pear vein yellows virus	see ASPV
RBDV	Raspberry bushy dwarf virus	raspberry, black raspberry
RpRSV	Raspberry ringspot virus	cherry, plum/prune, raspberry, strawberry, redcurrant
SLRSV	Strawberry latent ringspot virus	plum/prune, peach, cherry, elderberry, raspberry, strawberry, blackberry, blackcurrant, redcurrant
SMV	Soybean mosaic virus	passion fruit
SMYEPV	Strawberry mild yellow edge potexvirus	strawberry
ToRSV	Tomato ringspot virus	apple, peach, cherry, plum/prune, raspberry
TRSV	Tobacco ringspot virus	cherry, blueberry, papaya
